

# Luang Pu Mun Bhūridatta Thera

**Born** January 20th, 2413/1870 at Bahn Khampong, Amphur Khong Chiam (now Si Meuang Mai), Ubon Ratchathani

**Ordained** June 12th, 2436/1893 at Wat Si Thong, Ubon Ratchathani

## Pansah

- 1st-4th 2436-2439 (1893-96) at Wat Liap, Ubon Ratchathani (with LP Sao)

Goes off on tudong with LP Sao

- 5th-18th 2440-2453 (1897-1910) ?? 4 pansahs in Burma? (Moulamein 2, Mautama 2?)
- 19th-21st ~2454-2456 (1911-1913) at Wat Pathumwanārām, Bangkok (mostly going over to Wat Boromniwat to hear Tan Chao Khun Ūpāli's Dhamma)
- 22nd 2457 (1914) at Tum Sārikā, Khao Yai, Nakhorn Nayok; also tudong to Tum Phai Kwang, Khao Phra Ngam and Tum Singto in Lopburi
- 23rd 2458 (1915) Wat Burapha, Ubon Ratchathani
- 24th 2459 (1916) Khao Nong Sung Gao (Phu Pha Kuut), A Kum Cha-I, Nakhorn Phanom (now Mukdahan)
- 25th 2460 (1917) Wat Rang Bahn 'Huay Luang' (B Dong Po), A Nong Hahn, Udon Thani; also tudong through B Nong Phai, A Phanna Nikom, Sakon Nakhorn
- 26th 2461 (1918) Tum Pha Bing, T Nong Hoi (Na Sai), A Wang Saphung, Loei
- 27th 2462 (1919) Bahn Kor, A Bahn Peu, Udon Thani
- 28th 2463 (1920) Tum Phu Khao (Na Yung), B Na Yung, A Tha Baw, Nong Khai
- 29th 2464 (1921) Bahn Huay Sai, A Kum Cha-I, Mukdahan (OR Phon Chiang Wang (Phon Sa-Wang), T Song Dao, A Sawang Daen Din (now Song Dao), Sakon Nakhorn?)
- 30th 2465 (1922) Wat Pah Wanārām, B Kok Si, T Kok Si (Nong Laat?), A Warichaphum, Sakon Nakhorn
- 31st 2466 (1923) Wat Mahā Chai, A Nong Bua Lamphu, Udon Thani
- 32nd 2467 (1924) Bahn Kor, A Bahn Peu, Udon Thani
- 33rd 2468 (1925) A Tha Baw, Nong Khai
- 34th 2469 (1926) Wat Pah Bahn Saam Phong, A Tha Uthen, Nakhorn Phanom (with LP Sim, LP Gerng, etc)

Leaves disciples in care of LP Singh Khantayāgamo and goes off to finish his work

- 35th 2470 (1927) Bahn Nong Kohn, A Bung (Hua Taphaan), Ubon Ratchathani
- 36th 2471 (1928) Wat Pathumwanārām, Bangkok (studying with Tan Chao Khun Upāli)

Tan Chao Khun Upāli invites him to go with him to Chiang Mai, first staying at Wat Chedi Luang

- 37th 2472 (1929) Wat Araññawiwēk, B Pong, A Mae Taeng, Chiang Mai; also tudong to Tum Chiang Dao, A Chiang Dao (with LP Deu, etc)
- 38th 2473 (1930) Doi Jom Taeng (Wat Prathat Jom Taeng), A Mae Rim, Chiang Mai; also tudong through Wat Pah Huay Nam Rim, T Khi Lek, A Mae Rim
- 39th 2474 (1931) near Bahn Pohng, A Chom Tong, Chiang Mai; also tudong through San Pa Tong
- 40th 2475 (1932) abbot of Wat Chedi Luang, Chiang Mai (at Tan Chao Khun Upāli's request, Chao Khun Upāli passes away before pansah)
- 41st 2476 (1933) Wat Don Moon, A San Kampaeng, Chiang Mai (with LP Waen and LP Kruba Kamsaen); also tudong through San Sai up to
- 42nd-43rd 2477-2478 (1934-35) Tum Dok Kum, T Nam Phrae, A Phrao, Chiang Mai
- 44th 2479 (1936) Wat Doi Namō (Doi Nam Mua), T Mae Pang, A Phrao, Chiang Mai (with LP Waen and LP Khao)
- 45th 2480 (1937) Wat Pah Achaan Mun, B Goi, T Wiang, A Phrao, Chiang Mai (with LP Waen, LP Sim, LP Brom, LP Khao, LP Chob, LP Jia, etc); also tudong north through Wat Dong Pah Da, A Phrao
- 46th 2481 (1938) Wat Doi Muser (Prathat Jom Jaeng), A Mae Suay, Chiang Rai; also tudong through many places in Mae Suay and Mae Kachan
- 47th 2482 (1939) Pah Mieng Mae Sai, A Phrao, Chiang Mai (with LP Brom, LP Khao, etc)

Invited by Tan Chao Khun Dhammachedi (some say: LP Tate) to return to Isaan

- 48th-49th 2483-2484 (1940-41) Wat Non Phra Niwet, B Nong Nam Kem Duay, Udon Thani; also tudong through Wat Pah Sālāwan, A Meuang, Nakhorn Ratchasima (with LP Singh)
- 50th 2485 (1942) Wat Pah Bahn Kohk, A Si Suphan, Sakon Nakhorn
- 51st 2486 (1943) Wat Pah Bahn Kohk Namon, A Si Suphan, Sakon Nakhorn
- 52nd 2487 (1944) Wat Pah Bahn Kohk, A Si Suphan, Sakon Nakhorn
- 53rd-58th 2488-2492 (1945-49) Wat Pah Bahn Nong Peu (Wat Pah Bhūridattatherāwāt), T Na Nai, A Phanna Nikom, Sakon Nakhorn (with LD Mahā Boowa, LP Deng-on, LP Thongsuk?, etc)

**Passed away** November 11th, 2492 (1949) at Wat Suddhāwāt, Sakon Nakhorn

sotāpatti – Wat Liap 2438 or 2439

sakidāgāmi – on street in front of Wat Pathum School in Bangkok 2456

anāgāmi – Tum Sārikā 2457 (some say: at Khao Phra Ngam or Tum Singto)

arahant – Tum Dok Kum 2478 (some say: Doi Mon Laan, A Phrao, Chiang Mai)
